# STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

FLS International shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

# Withdrawal Policy (after the cancellation period)

## STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

FLS International shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later

Withdrawal Policy (after the cancellation period)

FLS International shall also provide a pro rata refund in school credit for unearned institutional charges to students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance. For students who have completed more than 60% of the period of attendance, no refund is due. FLS International may retain the remainder of charges.
