STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. 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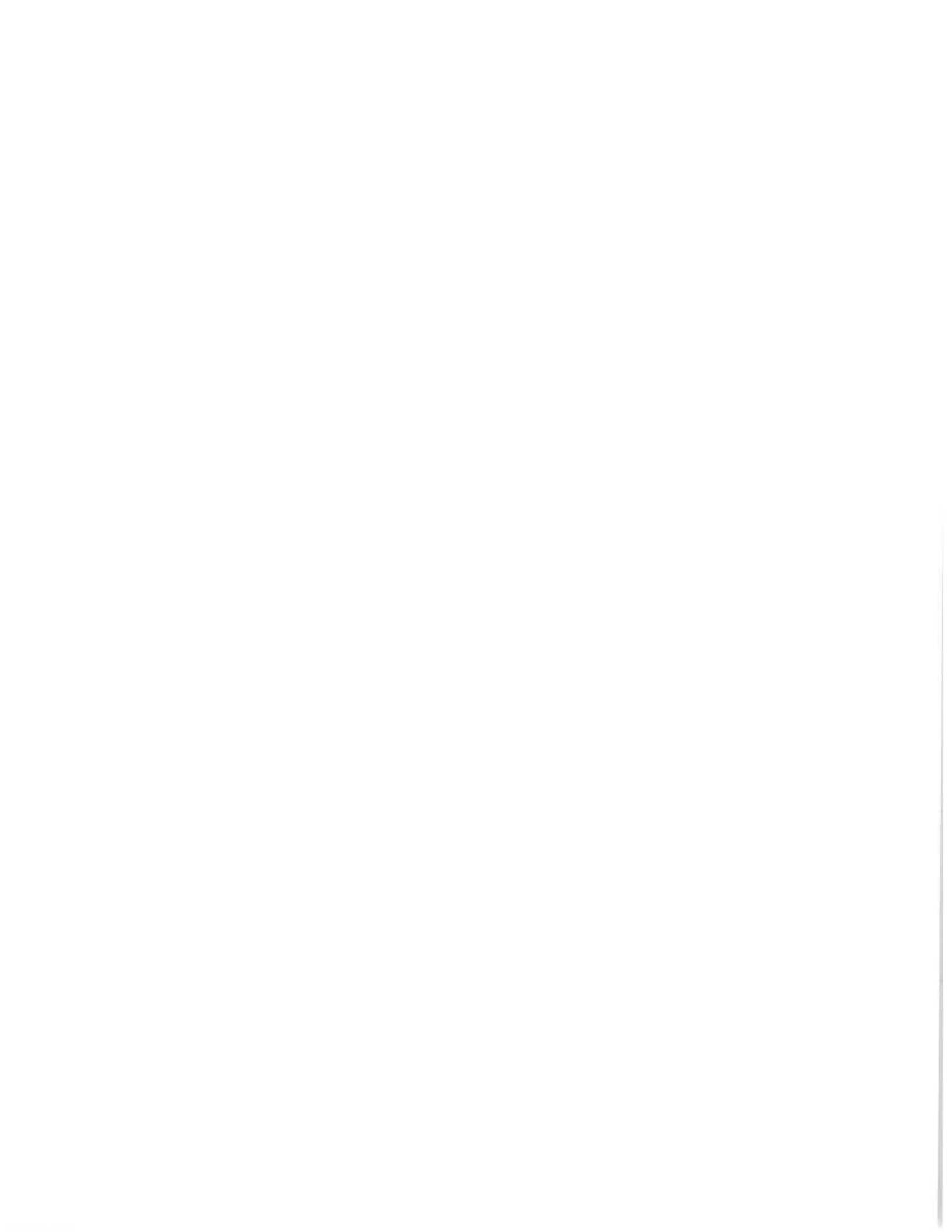

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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. If you fail to return this equipment, including books or other materials, in new condition within the 7-day period, the college will deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due to you. Once you pay for the equipment, it is yours to keep without further obligation. If you cancel this agreement, the college will issue a refund, less any non-refundable fees and deduction for equipment not returned within the 7-day period and in new condition, within 30 days after your notice of cancellation is received.

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

Definitions

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL
