#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

**STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL** the enrollment agreement for a course of instruction including any equipment, such as books, material, uniforms and supplies, or any other goods and services until 4 p.m., (5) business days prior to the first day of class. \*\*Business day means a day on which the student was schedule to attend a class session. Business day – defined as Monday through Friday 9:00AM – 4:00PM, excluding weekends and national holidays. Cancelation notice after 4:00PM will be considered as next business day. An email cancellation is required, for which the day emailed will be considered the effective day of cancellation.

- 1. All charges for the tuition fee paid by the student will be fully refunded, except for the registration fee if the student chooses to enroll in or to withdraw from the school within 5 business days prior to the class start date.
- 2. Student's that withdraw or is terminated on or after the first day of instruction will not be refunded for the registration fee, online course access fee, and the student tuition recovery fund fee.
- 3. If, after the first day, a student withdraws or is terminated, refunds will be made according to the following schedule minus the deduction of non-refundable fee's listed above:

- 4. If the school closes, cancels or discontinues a course program, the school will refund to each currently enrolled student full amount paid by the student for tuition and fees and all monies for which the student is liable for tuition and fees.
- 5. Students are requested to notify the Director or designated school official if they are withdrawing from the school.
- 6. The date of withdrawal or termination is the last date of attendance by the student. Refunds are based on the last date of attendance.
- 7. All refunds due will be paid within 60 days of the students last date of attendance.
- 8. In the case of an official leave of absence, if the student fails to return to training by the end of the leave of absence, the refund due shall be based on the date of withdrawal or termination and paid 60 days of the scheduled last date of the leave of absence.
- 9. The calculation of the refund shall occur after withdrawing the non-refundable registration fees, and online course access fees.

#### **Definitions**

- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam



in the reported calendar year.

- First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
