Student's Right to Cancel

- 1. You have the right to cancel this Agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, which is later. Cancellation shall occur when you have given written notice to the Student Services office. You are entitled to a pro-rated refund of non-federal financial aid program monies if you completed 60% or less of the period of attendance.
- 2. Should you voluntarily decline acceptance, fail to complete the terms of admission, withdraw via written notice, or be dismissed from the University for any reason, this agreement will be terminated. All refunds will be made according to the University refund policy which follows.

The student shall have the right to cancel the agreement and receive a full refund pursuant to section 71750 before the first lesson and materials are received. Cancellation is effective on the date written notice of cancellation is sent. The institution shall make the refund pursuant to section 71750. If the institution sent the first lesson and materials before an effective cancellation notice was received, the institution shall make a refund within 45 days after the student's return of the materials.

An institution shall transmit all of the lessons and other materials to the student if the student: (A) has fully paid for the educational program; and (B) after having received the first lesson and initial materials, request in writing that all of the material be sent.

If an institution transmits the balance of the material as the student requests, the institution shall remain obligated to provide the other educational services it agreed to provide, such as responses to student inquiries, student and faculty interaction, and evaluation and comment on lessons submitted by the student, but shall not be obligated to pay any refund after all of the lessons and material are transmitted.
