⁶ **150% Completion Rate** is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

⁷ **Graduates Available for Employment** means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for unemployment. "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

⁸ **Graduates Unavailable for Employment** means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave



the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

⁹**Graduates Employed in the Field** means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six month period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes the applicable educational program.

¹⁰ **Placement Rate Employed in the Field** is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

¹¹Number of Graduates Taking Exam is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

¹² **First Available Exam Date** is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

¹³ **Passage Rate** is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

¹⁴ Number Who Passed First Available Exam is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

¹⁵ **Salary** is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

¹⁶ **No Salary Information Reported** is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.



Student's Right to Cancel

The student has the right to cancel the Enrollment Agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after enrollment. Cancellation is effective when the student provides a written notice of cancellation to the Admissions Specialist. This can be done by email or by hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled the school will refund the Student any money they paid within 30 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
