- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

#### Full Refund

Students, who cancel their enrollment before the Friday of the 2nd week of classes, are entitled to receive 100% of the amount paid for instructional charges (except the non-refundable fees, if applicable). If the scheduled classes are canceled by the university, students will receive a full refund.

#### Effective Dates for Refund

Refunds are computed on the date the Notice of Cancellation/Withdrawal is filed in the Registrar's Office. The weeks listed on the previously mentioned Refund Schedule begin on the first day of the semester regardless of the day a student begins attending classes. <u>No tuition refund is given after</u> ninth week for full semester courses.

#### Effective Date of Cancellation or Withdrawal

All refunds due will be made within 30 calendar days from the effective date of cancellation or withdrawal. Students must deliver a signed and dated Notice of Cancellation/Withdrawal form (or any other written notice of withdrawal) in person or by certified mail to the Registrar's Office and receive a signed and dated receipt. The effective date of cancellation or withdrawal is the day which an official notification is delivered in person to the Registrar's Office. If mailed, the effective date of cancellation or withdrawal is the date postmarked.
