* This program is new. - “150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- “Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose

employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

- “Placement Rate Employed in the Field” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- “Number of Graduates Taking Exam” is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- “First Available Exam Date” is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- “Passage Rate” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- “Number Who Passed First Available Exam” is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- “Salary” is as reported by graduate or graduate’s employer.
- “No Salary Information Reported” is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

California law says: A student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges. SDATM shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less the application fee of \$50, if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Date to exercise the right to cancel or withdraw: May 28, 2021

To cancel the enrollment agreement and withdraw from the institution and obtain a refund, a student must send written correspondence to Arlyn Zones or Elizabeth Beringer at the Feldenkrais Institute of San Diego, 3680 6th Avenue, San Diego, CA 92103 or by email office@feldenkraisresources.com stating they would like to leave the program.

Furthermore, the Feldenkrais Institute of San Diego extends the Right to Cancel through the entire training.

During the course of training, if a Student chooses not to continue the training program—whether due to evolving personal or financial circumstances—a full refund will be made to the Student for any tuition paid in advance, that is any tuition paid for training days not

completed.

SDATM shall refund to the Student all tuition payments for any full-day training sessions of the program that the Student has not yet attended at the time of the notice of the Student's withdrawal.

The SDATM shall credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of monies not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
