Business day means a day on which you were scheduled to attend1 a class. Cancellation occurs when you give a written notice of cancellation. You can do this by mail, in person, by FAX or telegram. The notice of cancellation, if mailed is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state you wish to cancel the agreement. You will be given two notices of cancellation forms on the first day of class. If you cancel this agreement, the School will refund any money that you paid within 30 days after your notice is received.
- 2. Students are advised that notification of withdrawal or cancellation must be made in writing.
