Definitions

- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

1. All funds paid will be returned if the student is rejected for enrollment.

You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement, and obtain a refund of charges paid (excluding registration fee), for any equipment such as books, materials and supplies or any other goods related to the instruction included in the agreement, until the seventh day after enrollment or the seventh day after first scheduled class day, whichever is later.

Read the Notice of Cancelation form for an explanation of your cancellation rights and responsibilities. If you have lost your Notice of Cancellation form; ask the school for a sample copy.

- 2. After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time, and you have the right to receive a refund for the part of the course not taken. Your refund rights are described in the contract. If you have lost your contract, ask the school for a description of the refund policy.
- 3. If the school closes before you graduate, you may be entitled to a refund.
