- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

- 1. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: 5325 Engle Rd., Ste. 200, Carmichael CA 95608. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery.
- 2. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 4. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled, the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less the registration fee, not to exceed \$250.00, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.

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
