### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

- 1. You have the right to cancel your agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. - 2. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: California Hair Design Academy, Inc., 8011 University Avenue, Suite A-2, La Mesa, CA 91942.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. The institution shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.
