STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

SCC shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or

application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first-class session, or the seventh class day after enrollment, whichever is later?

Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the school shown on the top of the first page of the Enrollment Agreement. You will be given a Notice of Cancellation form [attached to this Agreement] to use on the first day of class, but you can use any written notice that you wish.

If the School has given you any equipment, including books or other materials, you shall return it to the school within thirty days following the date of your Notice of Cancellation. If you fail to return this equipment, including books and other materials, in good condition within the thirty [30] day period, the school may deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due to you. Once you pay for the equipment, it is yours to keep it without further obligation.
