#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student has a right to cancel his or her agreement for a course of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. After the end of the cancellation period, you have the right to stop school at any time. If you have completed sixty (60) percent or less of the scheduled days in the current payment period, you also have the right to receive a refund based on the percentage of time attended. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from student financial aid program funds. Student must exercise his/her right to cancel or withdraw by midnight of the 7<sup>th</sup> calendar day after enrollment.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**
