## Definitions

- 1 “Number of Students Who Began Program” means the number of students who began a program who are scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

## **Students Right To Cancel**

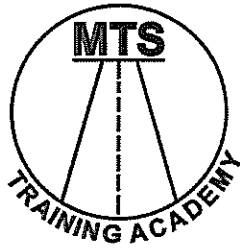

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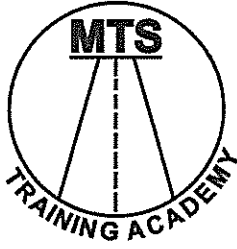

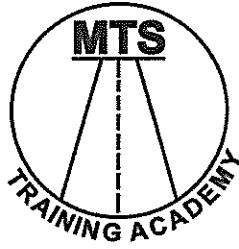
