- •"Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- •"No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Student's Right to Cancel for all modes of education (local and distance)

A student has the right to cancel his or her agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh (7th) day (calendar days) after enrollment, whichever is later. After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60 percent or less of the program which is in compliance with the California Education Code, Sections 94820 to 94824.

Such request must be made in writing on a Declaration of Cancellation Form (Form AS-1, if cancellation of enrollment occurs prior to or on the first day of instruction) or on a Request to Drop Class Form (Form AS-1.5, if Cancellation of enrollment occurs after the first day of instruction and before the 7th week of instruction) prescribed and furnished by CIHS for that purpose and shall be directed to the Admission Office at the Institute.

Such request shall be deemed to have been made on the day they are postmarked if they are mailed, or on the date received by the Institute if transmitted by some other means. Refunds will be made or credited within 30 days following the date upon which the student's withdrawal is determined.

Last Date to Cancel: I certify that I have reviewed my rights to cancel without penalty through attendance at the first class session OR the 7th calendar day after enrollment whichever is later.
