#### **DEFINITIONS**

- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Platt College San Diego complies with Title IV of the Federal Higher Education Act of 1965. You may cancel this contract by written notice, without any penalty or obligation, and receive a full refund of any money paid, through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation to the Registrar at the College's address shown on the front page of this Agreement. Withdrawal is for issues beyond lack of attendance. You can do this by mail, in person, by FAX or email. The email must be the one on file with the college and include a verifiable signature. If you cancel this agreement, the notice of cancellation, if mailed, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed and postage prepaid. This notice need not take any particular form. It only needs to state that you wish to cancel this agreement by mail. If you cancel this agreement, the College will refund any money that you paid less the registration fee and less any deduction for books and supplies not returned in good condition, within 45 days after your notice is received.
