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

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO WITHDRAW AND RECEIVE A REFUND. A student who has completed 60% or less of the program of instruction has the right to withdraw from the program and receive a refund of the unused portion of tuition fees and other reimbursable charges (*pro rata*). 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
