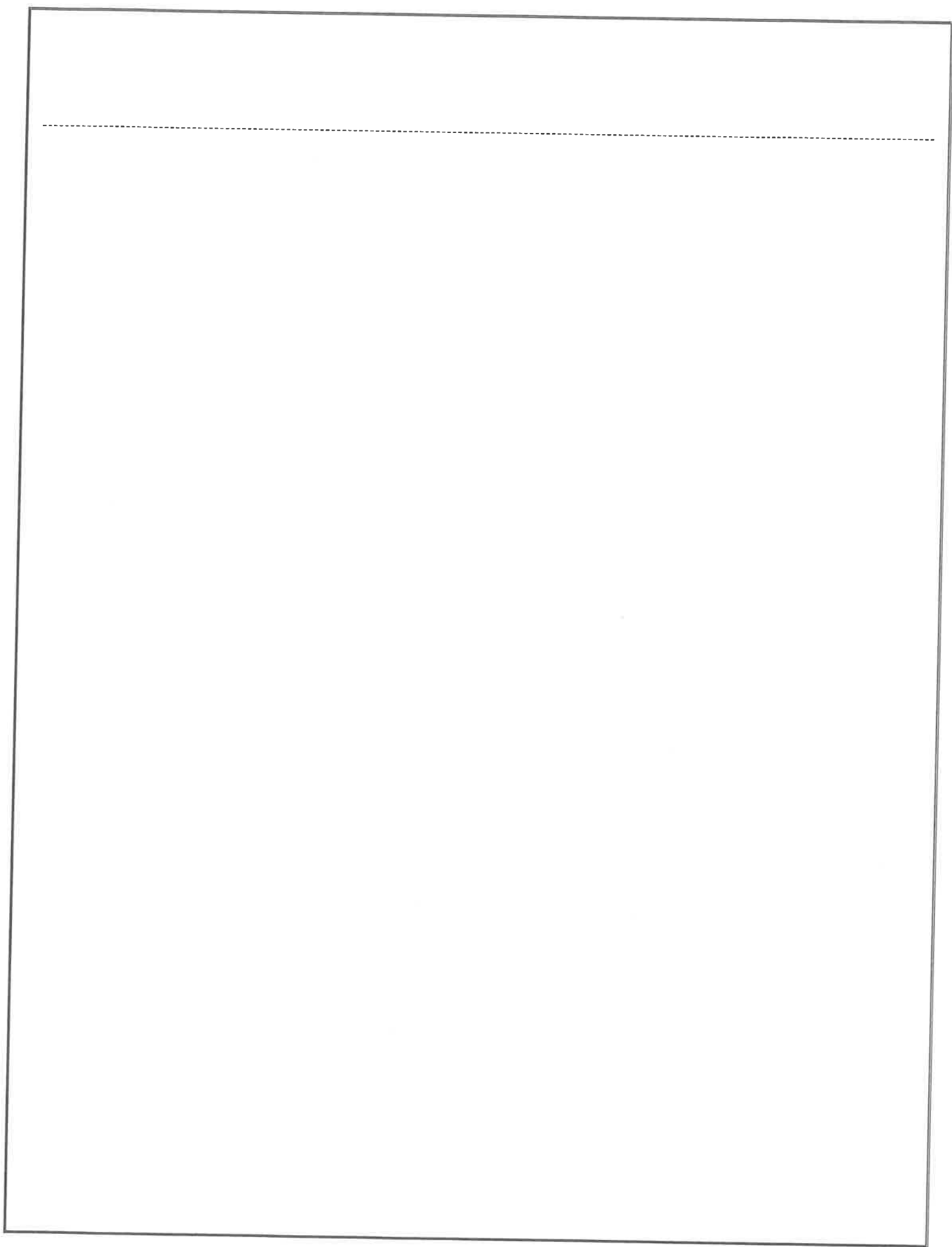

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Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL:

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through the attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after enrollment (date in which enrollment contract was signed), whichever is later. REFUND POLICY: After the cancellation period the institution provides a pro rata refund if student has completed 60% or less of the enrollment contract. **REFUND CALCULATION:** The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the number of days or hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days student attended or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal. Once student has completed more than 60% of the enrollment contract (including absences), there will be no refund to the student. If you withdraw from school after the cancellation period the refund policy described above will apply. Refund requests must be submitted in written form to Director of Bellflower Beauty College of Lakewood as soon as possible. Once received by either mail or hand delivery at the institution, Bellflower Beauty College of Lakewood has up to **45 days** to complete the refund request. If the amount you owe is more than the amount you paid, then you must make arrangements to pay the balance owed. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid funds.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY: The withdrawal date will be the last date of recorded attendance. The date the school terminates your enrollment due to academic failure or violation of BBC of Lakewood's rules and policies stated in the catalog. The date you failed to attend classes for a 30 day period and failed to inform BBC of Lakewood of your intention to withdraw. The date you failed to return as scheduled from an approved Leave of Absence your withdraw date shall be the last date of recorded attendance. Withdrawal forms are available at admissions desk.

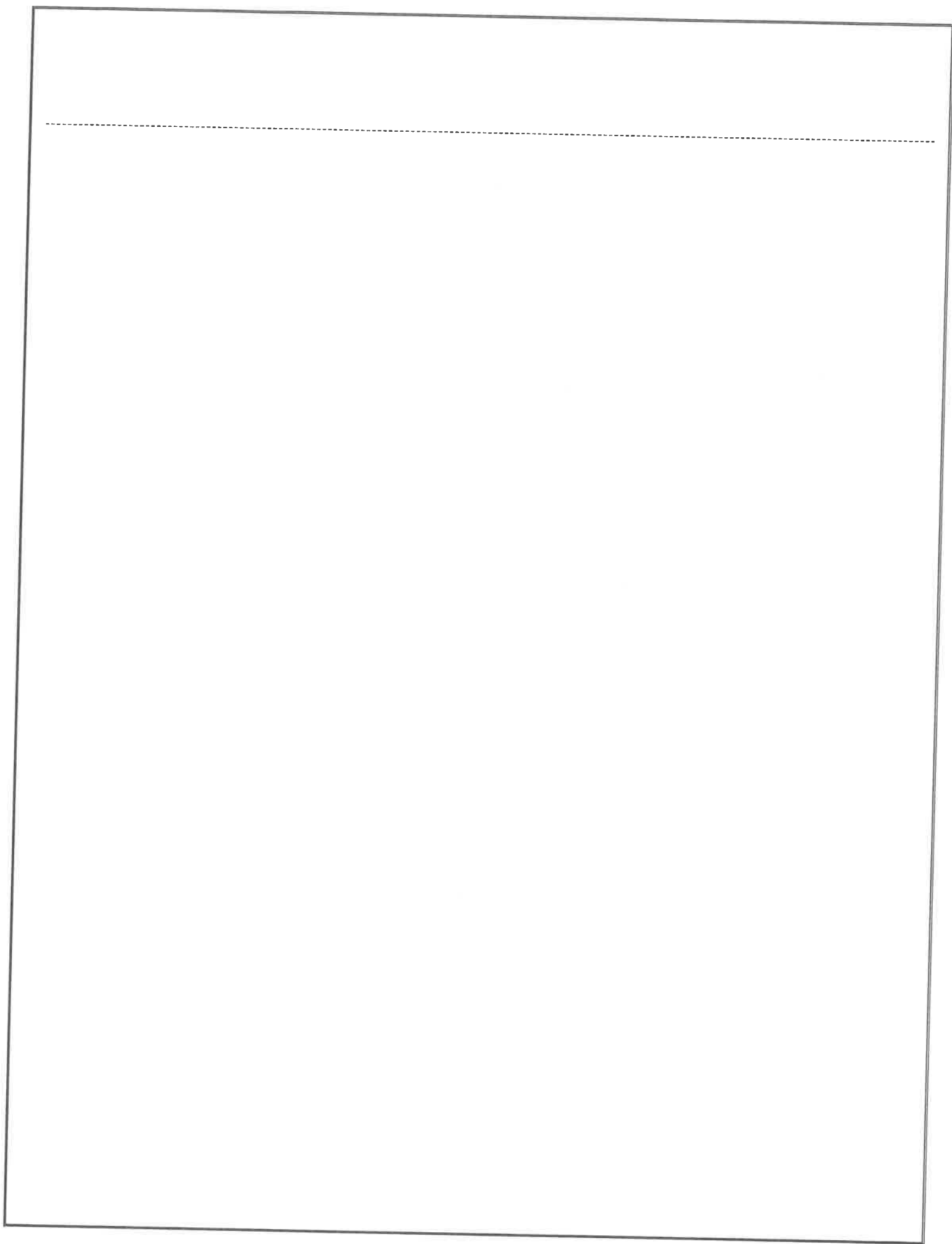
If the student has received federal student financial aid funds the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
