- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled by the student, or the prospective student is not accepted for the enrollment, the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less an application fee not to exceed \$100.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
- 6. If the program is cancelled before instruction begins, the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less any deduction for equipment open and use, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
