The amount retained for the registration fee may not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). In addition, the student may withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a pro-rated refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charge if the student has completed 60% or less of the instruction. For example, if the student completes only 30 hours of a 90-hour course and paid \$300.00 tuition. The student would receive a refund of \$200.00.

$(\$300.00 \text{ amount paid} \times (\text{unused hours } (60) / \text{total hours } (90))) = \200.00 refund

The institution shall pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal.

A check will be made available in same name of the person/organization who made the original payment at the Filbert address listed above on or before the 45-day window elapses.

FEDERAL AID

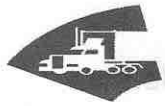

Definitions

- “Number of Students Who Began the Program” means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- “Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- “Number of On-time Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- “On-time Completion Rate” is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- “150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- “Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. Once notice is received, refund will be assessed in the following manner:

The student has a right to a full refund of all charges less than amount of **\$250.00** for the registration fee and any other non-refundable items if he/she cancels this agreement prior to or in the first day of instruction or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later. The amount retained for the registration fee may not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). In addition, the student may withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a pro-rated refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charge if the student has completed 60% or less of the instruction. For example, if the student completes only 30 hours of a 90-hour course and paid \$300.00 tuition. The student would receive a refund of \$200.00.

$(\$300.00 \text{ amount paid} \times (\text{unused hours } (60) / \text{total hours } (90))) = \200.00 refund

The institution shall pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal.

A check will be made available in same name of the person/organization who made the original payment at the Filbert address listed above on or before the 45-day window elapses.

FEDERAL AID

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from the federal student aid program funds.

LOANS

If the student obtains a loan to pay for an educational program, the student will have the full responsibility to repay the full amount plus any interest due, less the amount of any refund.
