STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund. The institution shall, for culinary students, without penalty or obligation, refund 100% of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or registration fee not to exceed \$200 and any late enrollment fees charged (if applicable), if the notice of cancellation is made through the first day of instruction or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. The institution shall, for distance learning students, without penalty or obligation, refund 100% of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or registration fee not to exceed \$200 and any late enrollment fees charged (if applicable), if the notice of cancellation is made through the first day of instruction or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Any discount applied to the original enrollment will become void upon cancellation. Refunds on materials in resalable condition will be granted if returned within two weeks after the first day of instruction. A 50% refund of the Student Services and Technology Fee will be granted if cancellation occurs within 45 days after the first day of instruction. After that point, the fee will be charged in full. A student is not considered withdrawn until a written cancellation has been received. Cancellation shall occur when a student gives written notice of cancellation at the address of the school shown on the top of the student's enrollment contract. The cancellation notice can be sent by mail, email, or hand delivery. If sent by mail, cancellation is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed, and with postage prepaid.

Students who are funded by third-party payers will have any cancellation refund paid directly from Bauman College to the third-party payer, not to the student. Refunds will be processed within 45 days of proper cancellation. Students who wish to cancel must be current with their financial obligations to the school. Tuition charges and fees will continue to accrue until a student's financial account is settled. Should a student wish to re-enroll after a cancellation, Bauman College will review eligibility for the student's readmittance based on the circumstances under which the student canceled. Re-enrollment will only be considered for the same program and must be processed within two years of the student's original enrollment date in order to receive credit for previous coursework.

Placement Rate Employed in the Field is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

Number of Graduates Taking Exam is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

First Available Exam Date is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

Passage Rate is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

Number Who Passed First Available Exam is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

Salary is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.

No Salary Information Reported is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.
