On page 3 of the 2020 Burbank Campus School Catalog, the catalog reads:

“Make-up Designory is a private institution and has been granted approval to operate by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (BPPE), www.bppe.ca.gov, under the terms of the California Education Code (CEC) Section 94890(a)(1) until February 3, 2023 per CEC Section 94890(b). Approval to operate with state standards as set forth in the California Private Postsecondary Act of 2009. Make-up Designory has never filed for bankruptcy petition, operated as a debtor in possession, or had a petition of bankruptcy filed against it under federal law.”

A revision has been made to correct specific verbiage to read:

“Make-up Designory is a private institution and has been granted approval to operate by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (BPPE), www.bppe.ca.gov, under the terms of the California Education Code (CEC) Section 94890(a)(1) until February 3, 2023 per CEC Section 94890(b). Approval to operate means the institution meets minimum state standards as set forth in the California Private Postsecondary Act of 2009. Make-up Designory has never filed for bankruptcy petition, operated as a debtor in possession, or had a petition of bankruptcy filed against it under federal law.”

GRADUATION RATES


Graduation rates are calculated by taking the total number of starts for the reporting period, removing all students who are unavailable for graduation (students unavailable for graduation are students who cannot complete the program due to medical conditions, military service or death), to determine the total number of students available for graduation. The total number of students who graduate is then divided by the total number of students available for graduation.
