# **Definitions**

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

# **STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL**

**STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL**: You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement, and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session \_\_\_\_/\_\_\_ (date), or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation at the institution's address. You can do this by mail, in person, by fax or telegram. The notice, if mailed is effective by postmark date. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state that you wish to cancel this agreement. If you cancel this agreement, California RDA Institute, LLC will refund any money that you paid, less any deductions for books and uniform not timely returned in new condition within 45 day after receipt of the notice.

**PROCEDURE TO CANCEL**: Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation to the Director of Student Services, **1059 First Avenue, San Diego CA 92101**. You can do this by mail, email, in person, by fax or telegram. The notice, if mailed is effective by postmark date. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state that you wish to cancel.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE**: The institutional refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course of instruction shall be a pro rata refund. After the end of the cancellation period, you have a right to terminate your studies at this school at any time, and you have the right to receive a refund for the part of the course or program you have paid for and did not receive. You have the right to withdraw from the course of instruction at any time. If you withdraw from the course of instruction after the period allowed for cancellation, the school will remit a refund, less a registration fee and the STRF fee within 45 days following your withdrawal.
