The Director will arrange an appointment to review the students account and determine the appropriate refund if applicable. Refunds are processed and disbursed from our accounting office within 30 days of processing via company check. Refunds are mailed to last address on file for student.

In addition, the student may withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a pro rata refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charges if the student has completed 60% or less of the instruction. **For example**, if the student completes only 20 hours of an 80-hour course and paid \$3600.00 tuition, the student would receive a refund of \$2700.00.

\$3600.00 amount paid for instruction X 80 clock hours of instruction paid but not received has paid = \$2700.00 refund amount

Students are not entitled to refunds of money's collected for sending to a third party on the student's behalf such as licensing or application fees if the services have been performed.

If the school cancels or discontinues a course or educational program, the school will make a full refund of all charges. Refunds will be paid within 30 days of cancellation of course.

In the case of illness or disabling accident, death in the immediate family or other circumstances beyond student's control, the pro-rata policy will be used to determine the amount of any refund if applicable.

All accounts have a finance charge of (1.5%) per month on balance due. Students not completing their course within the time as determined in the enrollment agreement must pay for all additional hours needed to complete course of instruction.

All changes or representations will not be recognized unless made in writing and signed by all parties. **MTS Training Academy** assumes NO responsibility for any negligence, carelessness or lack of skill by one or more students while practicing any part of the school course.
