Definitions

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student or legal guardian has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid except a \$100 non-refundable registration fee through attendance at the first class session (first day of classes), or the seventh day after enrollment (seven days from date when enrollment agreement was signed), whichever is later.

The notice of cancellation shall be in writing and submitted directly to the Registrar Office.
