- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" States or the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are
 called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing
 employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary
 institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six-month period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who
 took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number Who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

1.	You have the right to cancel this agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through
	attendance at the first-class session or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.
	Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation at School address shown on the
	front page of this agreement. You can do this by mail, in person, by FAX or telegram. The notice
	of cancellation, if mailed, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage
	prepaid. This notice need not take any particular form, it needs only to state you wish to cancel
	the agreement. You will be given two notices of cancellation forms on the first day of class. If you
	cancel this agreement, School will refund any money that you paid within 30 days after your notice
	is received.

Notice of cancellation must be received no later than ____ / ___ before midnight.

2. If School has given you any equipment, you shall return it to School within 30 days following the date of your notice of cancellation. If you fail to return this equipment in good condition within the 30-day period School may retain that portion of the payment paid by you and deduct the cost from any refund that may be due to you. Once you pay for the equipment, it is yours to keep without further obligation
