STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment and agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first – class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Cancellation shall occur when a written notice of cancellation from the student is addressed to the school. You can do this by Mail., hand delivery, or telegram. Written notice of cancellation by mail is effective when mailed, properly addressed, and postage prepaid.

The written notice of cancellation does not need to take on any particular form, not expression. Cancellation of the agreement Is effective once the student provides, in writing, that they no longer wish to be bound by the enrollment agreement. Each Student given two "Notice of Cancellation" forms on the first day of class. If the school has provided equipment, including books and materials, the student shall return these items to the school within 30 days following the tender of the, "Notice of Cancellation" form. If the student fails to return the equipment, including books and materials, in good condition, allowing for reasonable wear and tear, with the 30 day period, the school may deduct from any refund due to the student the cost for the items that were no returned or not returned in good condition. Once the students pay for the equipment, books, or materials then the student can keep these items without any further obligation.

If the student cancels their agreement, the school will refund any money the student paid, less any deductions for the equipment, books, or materials not timely returned or not returned in good codition.
