Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began Program" means the number of students who began the
 program who are scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published
 program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled
 during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after
 a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose
 employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification
 of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the
 six months periods begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first
 examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Cancellation disclosure from Enrollment Agreement shall be provided on a separate document in 12 point type and 1.15 spacing.

Caption shall state "STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL" in bolded 14 point type.

From page 2 of the Enrollment Agreement:

4. STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL IN CALIFORNIA.

The student has a **right to cancel** this enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance of the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. You may cancel this enrollment agreement and receive a refund by providing a written notice to the President of Community Christian College, 1174 Nevada Street, Suite 200., Redlands, CA 92374-2893.

6. The institution shall advise each student that a notice of cancellation shall be in writing, and that a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance. The institution shall pay or credit refunds within 30 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal. If the school cancels or discontinues a course or educational program, the school will make a full refund of all charges.
