<u>STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL:</u> The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first-class session (**first day of classes**), or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

The notice of cancellation shall be in writing and submitted directly to the Director, a withdrawal may be initiated by the student's written notice or by the institution due to student's academics or conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.

<u>Cancellation:</u> If a course is canceled subsequent to a student's enrollment and before instruction in the course has begun, the school shall at its option: provide a full refund of all money paid, less registration fee and application fee.
