- 6. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid programs. The School will refund any money that the student has paid within 45 days after the school receives your notice of cancellation. - 7. The institution shall advise each student that a notice of cancellation shall be in writing, and that a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not limited to, a student's lack of attendance.
