- 1 "Number of Students Who Began Program" means the number of students who began a program who are scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- 2 "Students available for graduation" is the number of students who began program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- 3 "Number of on-time graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- 4 "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- 5 "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed within 150% of the program length. (includes on-time graduates)
- 6 "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- 7 "Graduates available for employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- 8 "Graduates unavailable for employment" means the graduates who, after graduating, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave United States or do not have a visa allowing

employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

- 9 "Graduates employed in the field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- 10 "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- 11 "Number of Students Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- 12 "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after the student completed a program.
- 13 "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- 14 "Number Who Passed First Exam" Taken is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- 15 "Salary" is as reported by the graduate or graduate's employer.
- 16. "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

Students Right To Cancel

The student has a right to cancel this enrollment agreement and obtain a refund. You may cancel this enrollment agreement and receive a refund by providing a written notice to the School Director at MTS TRAINING ACADEMY; 140 Yolano Drive, Vallejo, CA 94589. Students may cancel enrollment on the first day of class or the seventh day after enrollment; whichever is later. The effective dates are

- A. An applicant not accepted by the School is entitled to a refund of all monies paid in advance.
- B. If a student cancels enrollment and requests a refund in writing on the first day of class or the seventh day after enrollment; whichever is later; the cost of tuition; less any applicable registration fees will be refunded within 30 days via school check. This policy applies regardless of whether or not the student has actually started training.

- C. For students who cancel enrollment more than seven business days after signing their enrollment agreement but prior to starting classes, all monies paid to the school shall be refunded less any registration fee. (Registration fee is not to exceed \$100.00)
- D. The school's refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course shall be a pro rata refund. Any monies due the student shall be refunded within (30) days via school check mailed to last address on file for student.
- E. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.
- F. To withdraw from the school, the student must submit a letter stating the intent to withdraw to the School Director. If the school cancels or discontinues a course or educational program, the school will make a full refund of all charges. Refunds will be paid within 30 days of cancellation of course.

In the case of illness or disabling accident, death in the immediate family or other circumstances beyond student's control, the pro-rata policy will be used to determine the amount of any refund if applicable.

All accounts have a finance charge of (1.5%) per month on balance due. Students not completing their course within the time as determined in the enrollment agreement must pay for all additional hours needed to complete course of instruction.

All changes or representations will not be recognized unless made in writing and signed by all parties. MTS Training Academy assumes NO responsibility for any negligence, carelessness or lack of skill by one or more students while practicing any part of the school course.
