You have the right to cancel your enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session or the seventh (7th) day after enrollment, whichever is later, as well as a pro-rata refund after that point up to and including 60% of the program. (CEC §94911(e)(1)(2)(3). You have the right to cancel the Enrollment Agreement and stop school at any time. After completion of more than sixty (60) percent of the scheduled clock hours in the period of attendance, you are not entitled to a pro-rata refund, and any funds remaining in your account will be considered additional earned tuition.

1. Cancellation/withdrawal occurs when the student provides written notice of cancellation at the following address: 22500 Town Circle, Suite 2205, Moreno Valley, CA 92553. This can be done by mail, email, or by hand delivery.
2. The written notice of cancellation/ withdrawal, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
3. The written notice of cancellation/ withdrawal need not take any particular form and, however expressed, is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
4. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled, the school will refund the student any money he/she has paid, minus a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$80.00.

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Definitions
