"STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL"

- 1. The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first-class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.
- 2. Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice at the address of the School shown on the front page of the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail, hand delivery or e-mail. Written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail is effective as of the post-date received. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form. You will be given a form to use upon enrollment, but you may use any written notice to inform the School of your cancellation.
- 3. If the School has given you any textbooks, equipment or supplies, you shall return them to the School in unopened/unused condition, within 7 days following the date of the notice of cancellation. If you fail to return textbooks, equipment or supplies to the School within this time period, you may be charged the documented cost for the textbooks, equipment or supplies. Once you pay for the textbooks, equipment or supplies, it is yours to keep without further obligations.
- 4. If you cancel this agreement within the specified time, the School will refund all payments, less any deduction for non-refundable items and opened/used books & supplies, within 7 days after your notice of cancellation.
- 5. The institution shall also provide a pro rata refund of nonfederal student financial aid programs monies paid for institutional charges to students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance.
