### **Definitions**

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### **STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL**

SCC shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first-class session, or the seventh class day after enrollment, whichever is later?

Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the school shown on the top of the first page of the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail, or hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid.

You will be given a Notice of Cancellation form [attached to this Agreement] to use on the first day of class, but you can use any written notice that you wish.

If the School has given you any equipment, including books or other materials, you shall return it to the school within thirty days following the date of your Notice of Cancellation. If you fail to return this equipment, including books and other materials, in good condition within the thirty [30] day period, the school may deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due to you. Once you pay for the equipment, it is yours to keep it without further obligation.

If you cancel this Agreement, the School will refund any money that you paid, less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within thirty days after your Notice of Cancellation is received.

The institution shall have a refund policy for the return of unearned institutional charges if the student cancels an Enrollment Agreement or withdraws during a period of attendance. The refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro-rata refund.
