The institution shall make the refund as per the calculation consistent with the California Code of Regulations. If the institution delivered the first lesson and materials before an effective cancellation notice was received, the institution shall make a full refund within 45 days after the student's return of the materials.

A notice of cancellation shall be in writing, and a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice to the school administrative office, **12400 Firestone Blvd Suite #240 Norwalk, CA 90650** or by email to <a href="mailto:info@erptechnicals.com">info@erptechnicals.com</a> or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.
