The institution, for all students, without penalty or obligation shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if the notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first-class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the Institution shown on the top of this Agreement by mail or hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and however expressed; it is effective if it shows that you are no longer wish to be bound by this Agreement.
