STUDENT'S RIGHTS TO CANCEL

The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Cancellation shall occur when the student gives written notice of cancellation to Edison Truck and Bus Driving School, Inc. at 1903 Durfee Avenue. South El Monte, CA 91733. The notice can be sent by mail or hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid and date of postage cancellation.

The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the contract agreement. The student will be informed at the time of enrollment of a Notice of Cancellation form to use, but the student can use their preferred written notice.

If the student withdraws from the course of instruction after the allowed period of cancellation of the agreement, the school will calculate any refund owed, less non-refundable fees, within 45 days of their withdrawal from the course of instruction. The student is obligated to pay only for educational services rendered and for unreturned equipment. If the amount the student paid is more than the amount that they owe for the time attended, then a refund will be made within 45 days of withdrawal. If the amount the student owes is more than the amount that they have already paid, then the student will be liable for that amount. The student will receive a Notice of Refunds within 45 days showing how the refund was calculated.

If a third party paid for the student's instruction, the Notice of Refunds will indicate when that party was sent the refund. Any student whose tuition is paid for by a third party, such as JTPA or State Compensation Insurance Fund, will not be entitled to any refund.

If the student has 3 unexcused absences or 5 total absences (excused or unexcused), the student will be dropped from the course program. The date that the student has been dropped from the course will be the date used to determine the 45-day deadline to notify the student of any refund due or amount owed. The last date of attendance will be the date used to determine the actual amount to be refunded or owed.
