Definitions

- “Number of Students Who Began the Program” means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- “Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- “Number of On-time Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- “On-time Completion Rate” is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- “150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- “Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- “Placement Rate Employed in the Field” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- “Number of Graduates Taking Exam” is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

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- “First Available Exam Date” is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel this enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later (CEC §94911(e)). This means that if your first class hasn't started yet, or it's been less than seven days since you enrolled, you can cancel with no penalty and request a refund. REFUND POLICY FOR INSTITUTIONAL CHARGES

In compliance with California Education Code §§94919 and 94920:

Pro Rata Refund – Nonfederal Aid Students:

Students who withdraw from training after instruction has begun and have completed 60% or less of the program period will receive a pro rata refund of institutional charges (CEC §94919, §94920).

100% Refund Upon Early Cancellation:

Students are entitled to a 100% refund of all institutional charges (less a non-refundable application fee not to exceed \$250) if notice of cancellation is provided:

- Before attending the first class session, or
- Within seven (7) calendar days of enrollment, whichever is later.

Definition of Institutional Charges:

"Institutional charges" refer to any tuition or fees paid directly to 1 on 1 Truck Academy for an educational program, including ELDT Theory, Range (Skills), Behind-the-Wheel Training, exam prep, and retest or DMV fees where applicable.
