STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL:

“RIGHT TO CANCEL – WITHIN THE CANCELLATION PERIOD”

1. Students have the right to cancel the Enrollment Agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first-class session (_____), or the seventh day after enrollment (_____), whichever is later. Cancellation will occur when student gives **written notice of cancellation at the address** shown on the front page of the Enrollment Agreement. A signed and dated notice of cancellation may be given by mail, hand delivery or telegram. The notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. The written notice of cancellation need not take any form and however expressed, is effective if it states that a student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement. Students who cancel their Enrollment Agreement will receive a refund of all amounts paid **within 45 days of cancellation**.
2. If a student obtains equipment specified on the Enrollment Agreement as a separate charge and returns it in good condition – allowing for reasonable wear and tear – within 30 days following the date of student cancellation, the school will refund the equipment cost paid by the student. If the student fails to return the equipment within the 30-day period, the school may retain the equipment cost paid by the student.
