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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

CANCELATION, WITHDRAWAL & REFUND POLICY

The student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Any student wishing to cancel or withdraw from class should deliver or send by United States postal delivery a written notice of cancellation or withdrawal to the Employed Security Service Center, Inc., 3530 Atlantic Ave., Suite 200, Long Beach, CA 90807; or cancelation or withdrawal may be demonstrated by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.

The institution shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). The Center shall issue a refund for unearned institutional charges if the student cancels an enrollment agreement or withdraws during a period of attendance. The refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund. The institution shall pay credit refunds within 45 days of a student's written notification of cancellation or withdrawal.

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of monies not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

The student shall have the right to cancel the agreement and receive a full refund of student paid fees before the first lesson and materials are received and/or outside licensing or testing fees are paid on the student's behalf.

Cancellation is effective on the date written notice of cancellation is delivered or received. The Center will make the refund as per the calculation consistent with the California Code of Regulations.
