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Definitions

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Student's Right to Cancel

You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, and obtain a refund of charges paid, through attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled days in the current payment period in your program through the last day of attendance.

Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation addressed to the Office of the Registrar at 3530 Wilshire Blvd., 11th Floor, Suite 1110, Los Angeles, CA 90010. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.

If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled within seven (7) days, the school will refund the student all money he/she paid, less a registration/processing fee not to exceed \$250.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 30 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
